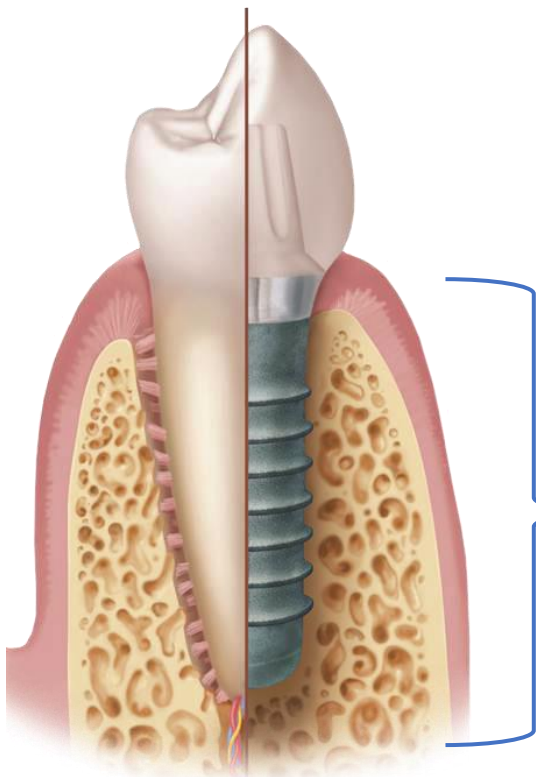


Extraction and Bone Graft



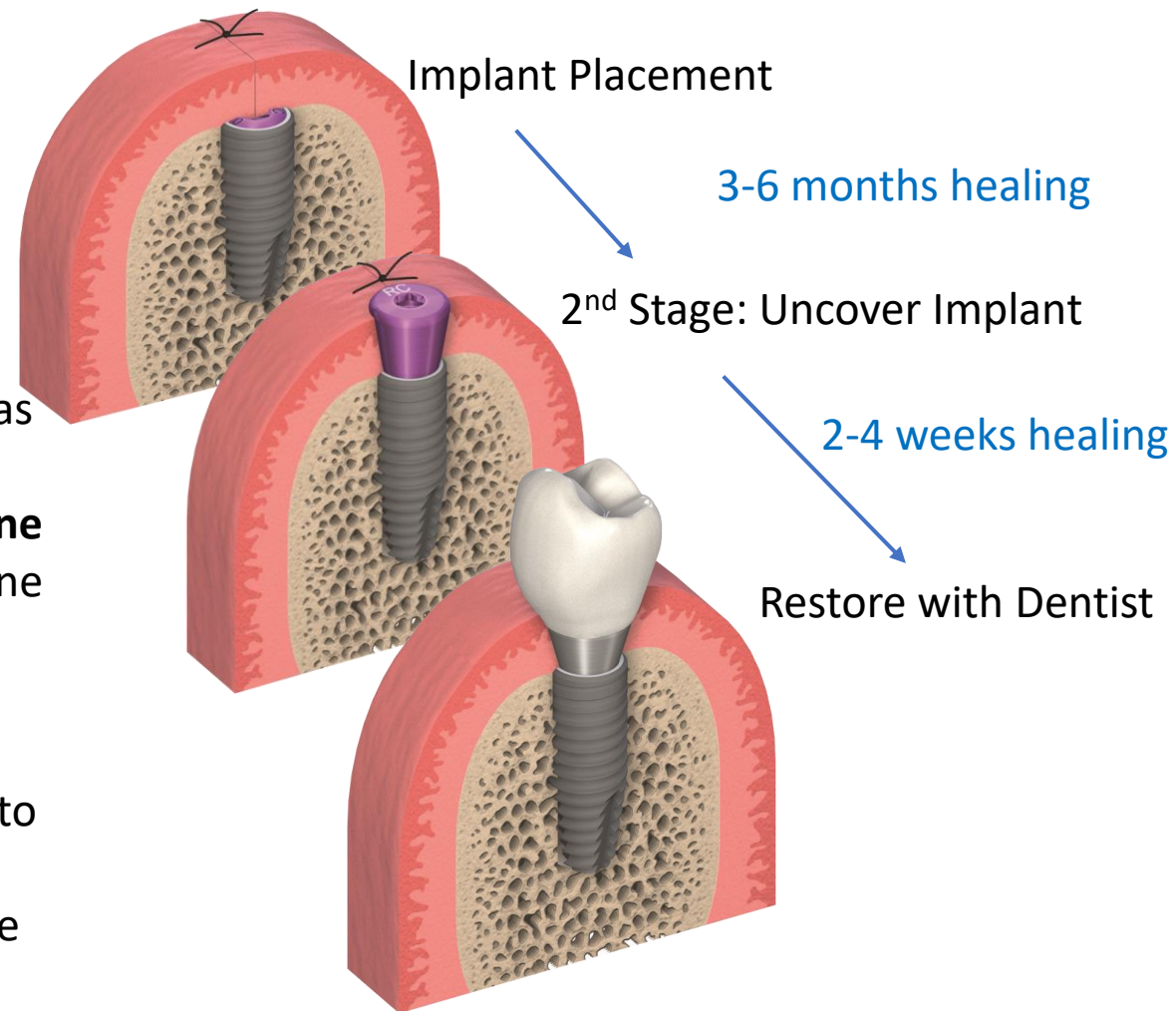

Adequate Bone

Often a tooth requiring extraction has bone loss. At the time of tooth removal, a **Bone Graft** and **Membrane** are placed to regenerate the lost bone and to preserve the remaining bone for a future implant.

The bone graft materials are sterile and serve as a scaffold for the body to turn over into new bone. Placing a bone graft allows for faster and more predictable healing.



4-6 months healing

Once the procedure is completed, the site will need to heal before an implant can be placed.
