


# Ridge Augmentation Bone Graft






## Adequate Bone

There must be adequate bone available to place a dental implant. A **Ridge Augmentation Bone Graft** is performed with a **Membrane** to contain the bone graft. This will need to heal 4-6 months before an implant can be placed. If needed, the gum tissue may also need to be replaced.




Before Bone Grafting



## 4-6 months healing

The membrane is used to contain the bone graft allowing adequate healing.



## Simultaneous

Sometimes the implant and Ridge Augmentation can be performed at the same appointment.
