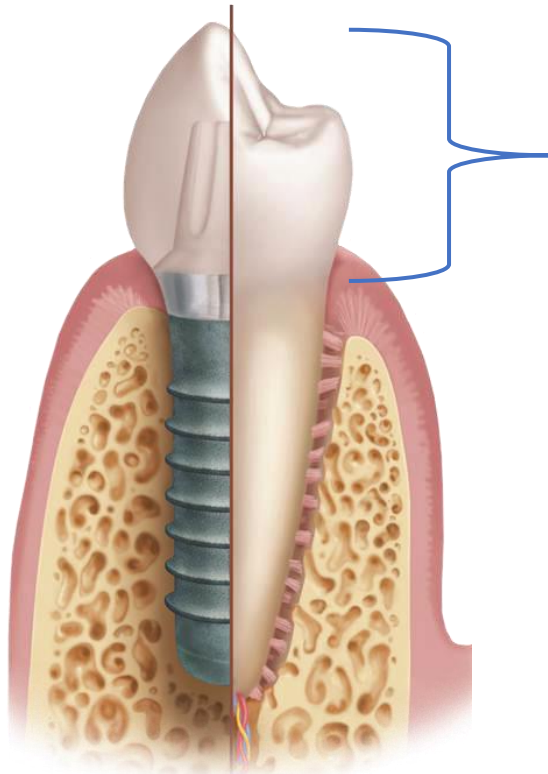
Healthy Gums, Healthy Heart

Adequate Tooth Structure

For a crown to be placed on a tooth, there must be adequate tooth available to retain the crown. If not, the crown will fall off.

A small amount of gum tissue and underlying bone is removed during this procedure.

Stiches are placed to hold the tissues back in place. These stay for 2 weeks.



Healing

After the procedure, the gum tissues need to heal at least 6 weeks before your dentist can place the final crown.
